**O**n November 21<sup>st</sup> the 157<sup>th</sup> Annual Communication of the Grand Lodge of New Hampshire took place. Below is a summary sent from Grand Lodge of the days preceedings.

**Subject:** 157th Semiannual Communication - November 21, 2015

Brother Henderson,

The 157th Semiannual Communication of the Grand Lodge of New Hampshire, F&AM, was held at Manchester, New Hampshire on Saturday, November 21, 2015, Most Worshipful Brother John F. Gordon presiding. The significant business follows.

#### Election

The election of Officers was held and the following were elected for installation at the end of the 227th Annual Communication on May 21, 2016.

#### Legislation introduced

1. After more than four years work, the Constitutional Review Committee has filed with the Office of the Grand Secretary, the new Grand Constitution, Manual of Grand Lodge, and the Rules and Regulations of Grand Lodge. These documents will be shared with the Lodges for action at the 227th Annual Communication on May 21, 2016.

2. Article XIII, Section 6.A was amended to increase the Grand Lodge per capita from \$43 to \$45. As planned, this did not receive the required unanimous vote for immediate adoption and will be acted upon again at the 227th Annual Communication on May 21, 2016.

#### **Fraternal Recognition**

1. The Grand Lodge voted to extend Fraternal Recognition to the Grand Lodge of Montenegro.

2. The Grand Lodge voted not to extend Fraternal Recognition to the Grand Lodge of Georgia (in Tbilisi) at this time, pending determination of the Commission on Information of the Conference of Grand Masters of Masons in North America.

The 227th Annual Communication of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the Ancient and Honorable Fraternity of Free and Accepted Masons for the State of New Hampshire will be held on Saturday, May 21 2016.
